CANCELLATION POLICY

- £750.00 to start offer – NO REFUND once access has been given to course materials
- Cancellations made more than 90 days before the course start date – full refund LESS £750.00.
- Cancellations less than 90 days before the practical training course start date – £750.00 deducted/no refund then 50% refund of any further monies paid.
- Cancellations less than 60 days before the practical training course start date – no refund applies – this is because our travel, accommodation and course materials costs have already been incurred.
- If a course is cancelled by Greyfriars due to unforeseen circumstances delegates already booked on the course will be given the choice of an alternative date or a full refund.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The entry requirements vary for each course/unit. For higher level qualifications and units we may require previous attainment of other relevant qualifications. INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students who do not have English as first language are required to have the following English language qualifications before registration (proof required).

- IELTS: 7.5 (with at least 7.0 in each element)
- TOEFL IBT: 100 with no less than 20 in listening, reading, speaking and writing
